How Cancer Card helps

When someone is affected by cancer, knowing where to start can feel overwhelming.

Cancer Card helps by:

- Bringing together trusted support services in one place
- Making it easier to find relevant, local, and national support
- Helping people access practical, emotional, and financial help
- Supporting not just patients—but families, carers, and loved ones

How fundraising can help



£10

Provides 150 Cancer Cards to cancer centres, GP practices, and community spaces – giving people access to vital support.



£25

Enables us to respond to a support call from a cancer patient, offering tailored information and guidance.



£80

Funds the supply and delivery of a Cancer Card comfort box for someone starting treatment.



£150

Covers a full day of community outreach work, connecting cancer patients with essential support services.

Choose an event that aligns with your interests and skills, and that will appeal to your community.

- Coffee morning
- Bake sale

AT WORK

- Dress-down day
- Office bake-off
- Step challenge
- Matched giving from your employer

COMMUNITY

- Quiz or bingo night
- Local café or gym partnerships
- School or university fundraiser

CHALLENGE

- Run, walk, or cycle
- Give something up

FEATURED

- Dine In, Help Out
- Host a meal. Invite guests. Ask for donations.

Your steps to success

1. Choose it

Pick something simple and enjoyable
(e.g. host a Dine In, Help Out dinner party or pizza night).

2. Set it up

Set a target, people give more when there's a goal!
Create your fundraising page.

3. Share it

Tell your story—why does this matter to you?
Ask people directly and spread the word.

4. Raise it

Collect donations and celebrate your impact!
Share updates (progress = more donations).

5. Thank you

Remember to send public and personal thank you's
to your donors!

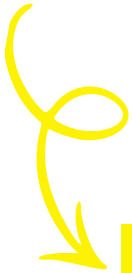




How to Donate

By consenting to Gift Aid on any donation, the charity can claim an extra 25p for every £1 you give from HMRC

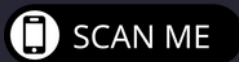
